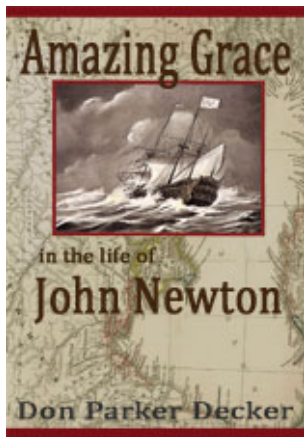


# Amazing Grace
